SPENDING over more than eight months and it is the then official United States Government report on Bolsheviks.

That part which deals with Russian propaganda is a résumé of the various activities directed by Ray-Mil, van Poper, and above all others. The report on Bolsheviks deals with the subject from a new angle. "The record includes the Constitution and a compilation of many of the so-called laws in force in Russia from which the nature of the paper government can be assessed, and the activities of many organizations of the attempted application of this paper government disclose the character and nature of the actual government in practical operation. The investigation which you conducted has shown that the situation is that few of either the advanced or conservative, in this country, of the present Russian Federal Soviet Republic are familiar with the fundamental principles upon which this Government is attempting to propagate itself. Consideration of the number and variety of developments in Russia has highly regenerated this agency to the possibilities and the activities that are inherent in the adult nature of most individuals and little or no appeal has been made to the intelligence of the people."

It is especially not surprising that the word "Bolshevik" has now become merely a generic term, and in America is nothing more than a slogan of the elements of current and discontent.

"By reason of their interest, as to what Bolsheviks are doing in political and social affairs in Russia, we have almost every illustrated sketch, from the radical unreturn to the theoretical



THE Senate Judiciary Committee will submit this week its report on German propaganda and Red Russia. The report has been available as an intelligence document since August 1941, extending over more than eight months and it is the first official United States Government report on Bolshevikism.

The report, which documents German propaganda, is a review of the various activities directed by Moscow, via Poles, and other plotters. The report was written from the point of view from a new angle. After telling what Bolshevism is, it applies the system, theoretically, to the United States and points out what would happen if the American Government were reduced to the pattern of the "red terror" at Russia.

In compiling the report Major E. Lowry Himes, engaged for the committee to conduct an investigation, gathered and interviewed information on Russia contributed to the archives of the American and British Governments.
