Salwar is a pajama like trousers, which is drawn in a tight manner at the waist and the ankles. The fold of Salwar is firm but its spread is loose which allows for flexibility. The women folk wear a long and loose tunic known as Kameez over the Salwars.

The hold of Silvare is firm but its spread is loose which allows for flexibility. The women folk wear a long and loose tunic known as Kamaze over the Silvare.

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To complete the getup, three straight meters of cloth called Dupatta is put across the shoulders in a round manner. There is another factor that has to be mentioned. On certain occasions women wear 'Churidar' instead of Salwar with Kameez, both are similar, but the Churidar is tight fitting at the hips, thighs and ankles.

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As they say, style makes an individual and subtle kameez suits this subjective to the felt. They make for bringing the new look and glam to the steps of ethnic fashion and (aise satwar kameez / subwar suits has a low up its class)
